
Our Unique Approach

AlcoholEDU for College

AlcoholEDU for College is a 2.5-hour curriculum designed for your entire first-year class. AlcoholEDU Ongoing

Prescription Drug Abuse Prevention



It prepares students to identify signs of abuse and addiction and equips learners with tactics for refusal and bystander intervention.

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
