What is the toolkit for?





- **Topics Covered**: the science of addiction, proper use and disposal of prescription drugs, and the dangers of fentanyl and counterfeit drugs







Discussing Tough Topics

Strategies To Support In-Classroom Discussions

These strategies are designed to provide guidance on how to navigate conversations during Red Ribbon Week that can be challenging. There are also discussion guides available that accompany many of our digital courses that you can leverage when introducing topics like prescription drugs, e-cigarettes, and mental health challenges.







Be Authentic

Reference a time that you made a mistake or weave a tactic that you use to manage your own well-being into conversation. 2

Be Prepared

Know your resources. Who can students contact at your school and in the community for further support?



Active Listening

"There are some things that I can do to help, or just listen. I could also connect you to a resource. What would be most helpful right now?"



Highlight Student Strengths

When a student comes to you with a personal issue, acknowledge the strength and bravery that it likely took them to come forward.

Practice What You Preach

The classroom is an important place to reinforce messages that students are receiving. Demonstrate that the lessons they learn online extend into the "real world."



Follow Through and Follow Up

It seems obvious, but If you say you are going to do something, do it. On the other hand, make it a point to check-in with the students after a conversation.
