3

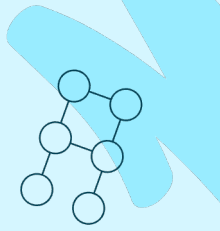
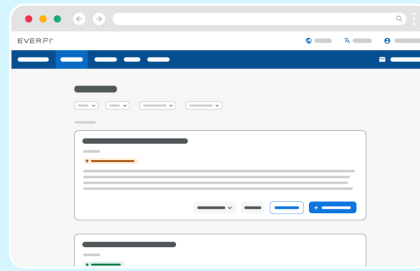
SUBMIT
