Construct an essay in response to a given prompt. Essays are typically 300–500 words in length.

3

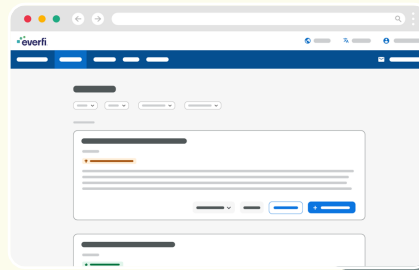
SUBMIT
